Earth Day Hero: \$1 - \$249

Throughout the year, Hirundo collects donations in honor of Earth Day, which is celebrated every April. With our goal of \$10K, funds **support conservation efforts made by Hirundo** in the care and maintenance of 2,460 acres of conserved wetlands and woodlands.

Youth Camp Champion: \$500

Hirundo offers **nature-based educational day camp** opportunities year-round for youth between the ages of **8-13**. Through the creative and fun day-camps, youth learn about all things nature, **become young stewards** of the environment, learn social skills and meet new friends. While this program has proven **beneficial for the emotional and physical well-being of youth**, it is a costly endeavor for Hirundo due to Hirundo's dedication to keeping registrations costs low.

Trail Steward: \$1,250

Hirundo offers more than **7+ miles of marked trails** free to the public year-round, including interpretive trails for kids and adults, and a universal access trail called the **Trail of Senses**.

This trail offers sensory and mobility impaired people, including older individuals, the opportunity to enjoy nature. **Sponsorship funds offset the high costs of maintaining each trail** throughout the year.

Paddling Sponsor: \$1,500

Paddling is an important niche of Hirundo – creating access to Pushaw and Dead Steams which run through Hirundo. **Hirundo offers free paddling gear every Saturday** spring through fall, **low-cost gear rentals** on other days, and **guided paddle tours** in a 28' canoe.

Nature Explorer: Bronze (\$250), Silver (\$251 - \$500), Gold (\$501+)

Sponsors in this category **support activities to connect individuals with nature**, including **free snowshoe rentals every Saturday** in the winter, **class field trips**, **guided hikes**, **citizen science activities**, and nature-based learning programs.
